The property underlying Saunders Park was donated to the TCLT in 2004 by Glenn and Janis Saunders to create a town center.

Glenn passed away in May 2015, just as the TCLT was finishing the Land Trust Room-- behind the Library & next to the Museum's beautiful native plant garden.
